


Like Ontario, much of Sweden's population is concentrated in the country's south. Stockholm has an average winter temperature that is 0.6 degrees C colder than Toronto's, yet Sweden uses 38% less energy per person than Ontario.



Solving the climate puzzle: The Swedish example

Despite a similar economy and climate, Ontario lags far behind Sweden, and even behind neighbouring New York State, in reducing greenhouse gas emissions.
