Additional Comments:

By continuing to store Darlington's radioactive waste in conventional commercial storage buildings on the shores of Lake Ontario, OPG is jeopardizing the health and safety of millions of people living in and around the Great Lakes system. Until a permanent storage solution is determined, radioactive waste must be located away from shorelines in facilities specifically designed to eliminate the risk of accidental or deliberate discharge into the environment.
